

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (the "University"), through University Behavioral HealthCare has operated the Shelter Plus Care Project (the "Project") for the provision of permanent housing for persons with certain psychiatric disabilities and chronic substance abuse disorders; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a collaboration between the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency ("NJHMFA") and the University; and

WHEREAS, in October 1996, the University entered into a financing, deed restriction and regulatory agreement with NJHMFA; and

WHEREAS, NJHMFA would accept "an agreed upon procedure letter" as an alternative to the full audit of the Project; and

WHEREAS, since FY 2000, PricewaterhouseCoopers ("PwC") has provided the agreed upon procedure letter attesting to the annual operating results of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the University requests the continuation of PwC services for FY 2006 and 2007 at an annual cost of \$8,000; and

WHEREAS, these fees have been presented to and recommended for approval by the Audit Committee, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey upon the recommendation of the Audit Committee, approve the fees for FY 2006 and 2007 not to exceed a total of \$8,000 per year.

WHEREAS, the property at 43 Bellevue Terrace, Collingswood, NJ purchased for \$54,000.00 in March 1996 is no longer needed for this program, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Collingswood has offered to purchase this property for \$60,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Legal Management has received and approved this transaction as to form and legal procedure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Vice President for Finance and Treasurer with advice of counsel is hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver all documents necessary to sell 43 Bellevue Avenue, Collingswood to the Borough of Collingswood; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey Board of Trustees upon the recommendation of the Finance, Investment and Administration Committee, accepts, approved and ratifies the sale of this property.
