- Founded in 1970 by the State Legislature as the College of Medicine & Dentistry of New Jersey; granted University status in 1981.
- 4 main campuses: Newark, Stratford, Camden, Piscataway/New Brunswick; branch campus: Scotch Plains.
- 8 schools, plus Newark's University Hospital and University Behavioral HealthCare.
- 185 acres, 64 buildings, 7.2 million square feet.
- Largest institution of its kind in the nation.
