

State of New Jersey Minimum Wage Law

On October 1, 2006, the New Jersey Minimum Wage increased to \$7.15 per hour. To comply with this regulation, Human Resources changed the rate of any employees falling below the \$7.15 per hour threshold.

A New Jersey Minimum Wage Advisory Commission was created to annually evaluate the State's minimum wage.
