### Tips on Installing Programs

- Install one program at a time. Completely finish the installation (which may require several sync operations) before you go on to install something else
- Pay close attention to the installation instructions - especially to prompts about memory storage
- In general, always store applications to your memory card when given a choice
- Complete any required registration. It is sometimes necessary for the programs to function properly.
- Consider wireless installation option if available and you have good WiFi on data access
- And afterwards, synchronize your device on a regular basis so your data is kept current

See some tips below for downloading each one.



1. Before you download the software to your desktop and then use the sync button on your PDA to have DynaMed transferred from your desktop to your PDA:

- Check your PDA model with the list of supported PDAs for downloading Dynamed at <http://libproxy2.umdj.edu/login?url=http://www.ebscohost.com/dynamed/technical.php>
- Register with Skyscape (create account on Skyscape website) at <http://www.skyscape.com/index/home.aspx> if you have not done so in the past.
- Later on while you sync DynaMed – transferring it from your desktop computer to your PDA, you will be asked for your Skyscape User Name and Password.
- Obtain a Dynamed serial number: E-mail [dynamedsupport@epnet.com](mailto:dynamedsupport@epnet.com) from your UMDNJ email account (no other email accounts will be accepted) requesting a serial number for your PDA device and PC.

2. Download and install Dynamed for the PDA or Mobile Devices at <http://libproxy2.umdj.edu/login?url=http://www.ebscohost.com/dynamed/technical.php>

- If at a non-campus location, you may be prompted to enter your CORE username and password or your library login
- Save the DynaMed file on your computer desktop.
- For Dynamed support, e-mail [dynamedsupport@epnet.com](mailto:dynamedsupport@epnet.com) or call (800) 758-5995
- Connect your PDA device to your computer and initiate a sync to transfer Dynamed from your desktop to your mobile device
- For an iPhone or iTouch Dynamed can be downloaded over your network connection directly to your device from the iTunes store

3. During the syncing process, your PDA screen will prompt you to...

- To enter your Skyscape Username and Password and the serial number for DynaMed

4. Sync your mobile device with your desktop again.

- Dynamed databases use at least 60mb of memory on a PDA
- Make sure you do updates frequently

## Essential Evidence Plus

1. EES is an evidence based medicine product you can download from the [PDA toolkit](#) or the direct link at <http://www.essentialevidenceplus.com/info poems/downloads.cfm>



- Click on the large button -"Download Essential Evidence Plus for all platforms" to place the files on your desktop. Be patient this download takes some time depending on your Internet connection.

- Connect your PDA (Palm or Pocket PC), Blackberry or iPhone/iTouch device to your computer via the appropriate connection, usually via a USB cable.
- Hit the appropriate sync button to transfer EES from your desktop onto your mobile device.

2. You must sync your mobile device with your desktop again or else Essential Evidence Plus files may not fully transfer from your desktop to your mobile device.

### 3. Register Essential Evidence Plus

- Under Manual Registration Instructions, click on the Essential Evidence Plus Registration Form link and provide the requested information.
- An email from Essential Evidence Plus will be sent to you with your License Code for this product.
- On your mobile device, type the License Code under > Menu > Register in the Essential Evidence Plus program. Click the button "Set License."
- At the end of each year, you will need to re-visit the link above and Re-register Essential Evidence Plus.
