Answers to the questions from the Mandatory Pre-bid Conference that took place on February 18, 2010.

1. Question Page 4: Is this a mandatory pre-bid conference?

Answer: Due to a typographical error on the letter dated February 12, to all bidders stating “non-mandatory”, and the bid stated “mandatory” this meeting is non-mandatory.

2. Question: Page 1: Which attachment of drawings should we use if there is a conflict?

Answer: Please use the new attachments which are part of the addendum. The counter tops are continues with no drop down sections. The heights of the counters can be found in the new attached drawings.

3. Question: Page 13 Can we use an equal product to Corian?

Answer: An approved equal is accepted.

4. Question: Who is responsible for the towel dispenser in the front of the work stations?

Answer: The towel dispenser is not required. The opening in the counter face is not required for towel dispenser.

10. Question Page 23: is this prevailing wages?

Answer: Yes and regular work hours.

11. Page 50 Section 7.1.3 TIME TABLE- change the start date to April 01, 2010.

12. Price Sheet Page 54: Remove "total price for bookcase"

13. Question: Page 14 does the free standing walls need removable panels?

Answer: Yes.

14. Question: Page 14 what is meant by "hallow"

Answer: Standard Definition, Not Solid.

15. Question: Page 13 what type of material is the exterior of these walls? If the material is steel can plastic laminate or phenolic be acceptable?

Answer: Must match casework finish.
