www2.umdj.edu/rwjlweb. Please bookmark this site for easy access to dozens of databases, hundreds of textbooks and thousands of journals that will assist you with your needs.

Our electronic resources are available off-campus to all members of the UMDNJ community. In order to access UMDNJ resources remotely, you must be a registered library user. When off-campus you will be

prompted for an ID and password. Your ID is your last name and your password is the last 4 digits of your UMDNJ ID number. More information on remote access is located on our website at <http://www.umdj.edu/librweb/access/>

UMDNJ faculty, staff and students on the New Brunswick/Piscataway campus may also utilize select services at Rutgers University Libraries. Services are granted for one academic year. Individuals eligible for services may register, and must re-qualify annually for continued services, at the circulation desks at either the Rutgers University Alexander Library or the Library of Science and Medicine. Remote access privileges to use Rutgers University licensed electronic infor-

mation resources are extended to UMDNJ students, faculty, and staff enrolled in or employed by the joint Rutgers/UMDNJ Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences (GSBS) and School of Public Health (SPH) on the New Brunswick and Piscataway campuses.

Other Clinical Decision Making Tools

Access Medicine delivers the latest medical advances and knowledge from recognized physicians delivered in a digital aggregation with online desktop, PDA, iPod, and MP3 compatible device solutions. Clinical books, images, USMLE-formatted questions, and much more.

Books@Ovid contains a full text collection of medical, nursing and pharmacy textbooks.

MDConsult provides searchable, full-text access to medical journals, books, over 1000 clinical practice guidelines, a drug database and 3500 customizable patient education handouts.

STAT!Ref includes full text medical nursing, and pharmacology textbooks.

Printing and Copying

Library photocopiers and printers require the use of a copy card. Cards can be purchased for \$1.00 at the Jamex station located next to the Circulation desk. Copies can be added to the card

at the rate of 10 cents per page. Before purchasing a card, check with your department to see if they have a library copy card for your use. Two computers located outside the MEB Library in New Brunswick are

now configured to work with UMDNJ's Printer Quota Management (PQM) system. These computers require that you log in using your CORE username and password.

Print jobs can be retrieved from a printer located behind the library's reference desk. Students and employees are allotted 800 free printer pages per year, from July 1 through June 30.

Download EndNote Free

EndNote is a bibliographic software program, used by millions of researchers, faculty, and students to search databases, organize references and create instant bibliographies. EndNote enables you to collect and download your references from online catalogs and databases for inclusion in presentations and papers. Create a subject bibliography with topic headings for producing curricula vitae and reading lists easily. Place figures and tables stored in EndNote anywhere in a Microsoft Word document to create reports in a snap. Or, mobilize your EndNote Library using Palm OS.

We are licensed to provide download access of EndNote only for our UMDNJ affiliated users. You will be prompted to login with the [UMDNJ Remote Access service](#) when you choose a download version. After downloading the program you will need to install the EndNote program. The Macintosh versions need to be unzipped first.
