

## Michael L. Barnett, D.D.S.

Dr. Michael Barnett currently serves as Interim Associate Dean for Research and Clinical Professor of Oral Biology at New Jersey Dental School. He previously spent more than 14 years in industry as Senior Director of Dental Affairs and Technology Development for Warner-Lambert Company (later Pfizer Inc.) Consumer Healthcare Research and Development. In this capacity, he was responsible for dental product clinical trials, the identification and evaluation of new technologies, and professional relations, and represented the company before organizations such as the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, the American Dental Association, and the British Dental Association. Prior to joining industry, he held academic positions in departments of periodontology at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, SUNY at Buffalo, and the University of Louisville, and served as Chairman of the Department of Dentistry at Morristown Memorial Hospital and Clinical Associate Professor in the Division of Periodontics at Columbia University's School of Dental and Oral Surgery. He has published more than 100 peer reviewed papers and abstracts, as well as a series of 17 Guest Editorials in the *Journal of Dental Research*.

Dr. Barnett received his D.D.S. degree from Columbia University's School of Dental & Oral Surgery and held postdoctoral fellowships at the University of Washington and at Harvard University, receiving a Certificate in Periodontology and Oral Medicine from the latter institution. He served in the Army as Chief of Oral Medicine at Fort Lewis, Washington, and was awarded the Army Commendation Medal. Dr. Barnett is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and of the American College of Dentists, and is the 2002 recipient of the American Association for Dental Research *Jack Hein Public Service Award*.
