Dr. Gaur has been a Pediatric Infectious Disease specialist and an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, Robert Wood Johnson Medical School since 1987. She received her medical degree from King George Medical College in Lucknow, India.

Dr. Gaur has been working with children and families with HIV/AIDS since 1983 when the first child was diagnosed with AIDS in Central New Jersey. She has been the Director of the Robert Wood Johnson AIDS Program in New Brunswick, New Jersey since 1995, which is one of the largest Pediatric HIV programs in New Jersey. Dr. Gaur has also been the Principal Investigator of Pediatric AIDS Clinical Trials conducted at this site since 1995.

Since 1998, Dr. Gaur has been the Chairman of the Advisory Committee of the New Jersey Statewide Family Centered HIV Care Network, a Title IV network of the seven pediatric HIV centers in New Jersey, working collaboratively to enhance the standards of HIV care statewide and collectively providing an active voice in statewide advocacy for HIV related issues.
