### High Risk/ High Alert Medications

1. Chemotherapeutic Agents (e.g. Methotrexate, Cisplatin, Carboplatin, Paclitaxel, Docetaxel, Vinblastine, Vincristine etc.)
2. Heparin
3. Fosphenytoin/ Phenytoin IV
4. Digoxin IV
5. Neuromuscular Blocking Agents (e.g. Mivacron®, Norcuron®, Pavulon®, Quelicin®, Nimbex®, Zemuron® etc.)
6. Colchicine IV
7. Insulin Products (e.g. Novolin R, Novolin N, Novolog, Lantus, Novolog Mix 75/25, ULTRALente, Lente)

*The concentrated electrolyte solutions that have been removed from the patient care areas at University Hospital are:*

1. Concentrated Potassium Chloride Injection (Vials)
2. Potassium Phosphate Injection (Vials)
3. Sodium Phosphate Injection (Vials)
4. Magnesium Sulfate Injection (Greater than 2ml)
5. Sodium Chloride (Greater than 0.9%)

5. Clonidine and Clonazepam
6. Dopamine and Dobutamine
7. Diflucan and Diprivan
8. Heparin and Hespan
9. Retrovir and Ritonavir
10. Pitocin and Pitressin
11. Insulin Products ( e.g. Lantus and Lente, Humalog and Humulin, Novolog and Novolin, Humulin and Novolin, Humalog and Novolog, Novolin 70/30 and Novolog Mix 70/30)
